Based on the cookies set up on BHDP's website, some of them collect IP addresses and browsing activities. Please see below for more information.

1. Cloudflare Cookies:

- __cf_bm, _cfuvid:
 - Purpose: These cookies are set by Cloudflare, a web security and performance service. The __cf_bm cookie is used to manage incoming traffic and distinguish between human visitors and bots. The _cfuvid cookie tracks individual visitors anonymously.
 - Data Collected: Likely collects IP addresses for security reasons, such as protection against DDoS attacks and spam. Cloudflare generally anonymizes IP addresses where possible.

2. HubSpot Cookies:

- __hs_cookie_cat_pref, __hssc, __hssrc, __hstc, hs_c2l, hs_login_email, hubspotapi-lax, hubspotapi-strict, hubspotutk:
 - Purpose: These are set by HubSpot to track user behavior across the site, manage user sessions, and store user preferences.
 - Data Collected: HubSpot cookies can track browsing activity (pages visited, time spent on the site), session information, and possibly IP addresses. hubspotutk is used to track visitor identities, often in combination with IP address and behavior data.

3. Google Analytics Cookies:

- _ga, _ga_L66PWR7N6T, _gat_UA-74602235-1, _gid:
 - Purpose: These cookies are set by Google Analytics for tracking user behavior across the site, such as page visits, user interactions, and session duration. _ga is the main cookie that distinguishes individual users by assigning them a unique ID.
 - Data Collected: Google Analytics can track browsing activity, and unless IP anonymization is enabled, it also collects IP addresses. _gat cookies are used to throttle the request rate to Google Analytics.

4. Facebook Pixel:

- _fbp:
 - Purpose: Set by Facebook to deliver advertising when users are on Facebook or a digital platform powered by Facebook advertising after visiting the site.
 - Data Collected: Tracks browsing activity (e.g., pages visited, conversions), and often collects IP addresses to associate actions with specific users or devices for advertising purposes.

5. Google Services and ReCAPTCHA Cookies:

- AEC, NID, SOCS, UULE, _GRECAPTCHA, APISID, HSID, SAPISID, SID, SIDCC, SSID, _Secure-1PAPISID, _Secure-1PSIDCC, _Secure-1PSIDTS, _Secure-3PAPISID, _Secure-3PSIDCC, _Secure-3PSIDTS:
 - Purpose: These are Google cookies used for various services like Google Maps,
 Google login authentication, and reCAPTCHA (which protects the site from bots).
 - Data Collected: Typically collects IP addresses, geolocation, and browsing data, particularly related to user interactions with Google services. reCAPTCHA collects user behavior information to ensure the visitor is human and not a bot, and this includes analyzing IP addresses.
